

## Important Customer Rate Information

The Florida Public Service Commission recently approved two adjustments to Gulf Power rates that are effective March 2, 2021. The adjustments include a change to the Environmental Cost Recovery Clause (ECRC) factor for the remainder of 2021 to reflect the savings associated with the early retirement of coal at Gulf Clean Energy Center, as well as the beginning of recovering storm restoration costs for Hurricane Sally.

The following summary includes the adjusted rates applicable March 2, 2021, as well as the annual cost recovery clause adjustments effective in January 2021 and the Hurricane Michael storm restoration surcharge that was effective in December 2020.

## Residential Service (RS)

Base Charge	64¢ per day
Base Rate Energy Charge	4.886¢/kWh <sup>1</sup>
Fuel Charge	3.070¢/kWh

<sup>1</sup> The Energy Charge that appears on a residential (RS) customer's bill includes the base rate energy charge shown above, plus 1.621¢/kWh environmental compliance costs, 0.915¢/kWh for purchased power capacity costs, 0.090¢/kWh for energy conservation program costs, 0.037¢/kWh for storm protection plan costs, 0.800¢/kWh for the Hurricane Michael storm restoration surcharge, and 0.300¢/kWh for storm restoration costs associated with Hurricane Sally.

## Energy Select Residential Service Variable Pricing (RSVP)

Base Charge	64¢ per day
Base Rate Energy Charge	4.886¢/kWh <sup>2</sup>
Fuel Charge	3.070¢/kWh

<sup>2</sup> For those residential customers electing the (RSVP) option, the Energy Charge that appears on their bill includes the base rate energy charge shown above, plus 1.621¢/kWh for environmental compliance costs, 0.915¢/kWh for purchased power capacity costs, 0.037¢/kWh for storm protection plan costs, 0.800¢/kWh for the Hurricane Michael storm restoration surcharge, 0.300¢/kWh for storm restoration costs associated with Hurricane Sally, and the following charges for energy conservation program costs:
